

How to tell the difference between Real and Faux Fur



Real fur
Pointed ends



Faux fur
blunt ends



Real fur
Animal skin base



Faux fur
Woven fabric base

Check the fur tips

Real fur tapers to a point at the end (unless sheared). Faux fur tips are blunt.

Check the fur base

Part the hairs at the base. Faux fur is attached to woven fabric. The base of real fur is an animal's skin (leather).

The burn test

If you already own the item, safely cut and burn a few hairs. Real animal fur sings and smells like burnt human hair. Faux fur melts and smells like burnt plastic.

If in doubt, don't buy it!
